

100.3 The Peak Collects over \$305,000 for New Mexico's Children

100.3 The Peak raised \$310,712.42 during the 3rd annual Peak Radiothon. The money collected will be used to benefit the Children's Miracle Network and the University of New Mexico's Children's Hospital. Jackie, Tony, and Donnie, from the Peak's morning show, broadcasted live from the children's hospital from 6a.m. – 6p.m. for 3 days. During their broadcast the morning show visited with patients and families who are being treated or have been treated at the children's hospital. The patients and families told their stories on air in an effort to inspire people in the community to donate money. This year's Radiothon raised \$69,700.00 more than the 2006 Radiothon. Over the 3 years of the Radiothon, KPEK has raised a total of \$807, 524.00 for the hospital and the children being treated there.
