The need for blood never takes a vacation. Daily, local patients depend on 1100 blood donors to register with Carter BloodCare. Each routine donation has the potential to help an average of three patients. Although blood donors with all blood types are needed, those with Type O blood are particularly encouraged to donate. Volunteer blood donors must be at least 17 years old, bring a photo ID and be in good general health. There is no upper age limit for donors, and most medications do not interfere with donor eligibility.
