Bob Craig, host of Martini Lounge Radio's "Do-Be-Do Lunch with Frank Sinatra" will serve as master of ceremonies and broadcast the event live on location from South Philadelphia at Galdo's Catering, 20<sup>th</sup> and Moyamensing from 11 am to 1pm. The unveiling ceremony will take place promptly at noon outside, weather permitting.

Joining Bob Craig in the ceremony will be Kevin McAdams - Philadelphia Postmaster, Frank Neri - District Manager of the Philadelphia Metropolitan Area, Tom Kelly - President of Marconi Broadcasting's Martini Lounge Radio and Lou Galdo, owner of Galdo's Catering. The ceremony will also feature two songs performed live by Frank Sinatra tribute artist, Rich DeSimone. By day, Mr. DeSimone is a letter carrier for the USPS.
