### B103.9 Emergency Radio Marathon Raises Over \$10,000 To Aid Humane Society After Theft.

On a Monday morning, employees of Gulf Coast Humane Society in Fort Myers, Florida, arrived at work to discover the building had been burglarized and over \$7,000 in brand new computer equipment and other supplies for the new low-cost public veterinary clinic scheduled to open in March had been stolen.

In two days, the team at B103.9 had organized and publicized an emergency radio marathon, to take place Wednesday, 6am – 6pm. Listeners calling in with a donation of \$20 or more had their song request played on the air. The listener who made the largest contribution received a pair of tickets to see the Jonas Brothers in concert plus a meet & greet with the band. Contributions were also accepted online and in person at the studio and a local mall.

They hoped to raise \$8,000.00 to cover the cost of the stolen items. Thanks to a quick response, a huge team effort and a caring, generous community, \$10,250.00 was raised for the humane society in 12 hours.
