Aldean's 2012 tour is hitting the nation's biggest amphitheaters this year. He is setting attendance records across the country, including his first stadium sellout in Columbus, OH. 2011 saw Aldean earn Double Platinum certification for his fourth studio album, My Kinda Party – the top-selling country full-length of the year and CMA's Album Of The Year. With a new record on the way, Aldean is poised for even more success in 2012.

Luke Bryan's latest album, last year's Platinum-certified tailgates & tanlines, debuted at No. 1 on the Billboard Top Country Albums chart and No. 2 on the Billboard Top 200 chart. It features three back to back Platinum-certified digital singles "Country Girl (Shake It for Me)," "I Don't Want This Night to End" (also CMT's Male Video Of The Year) and "Drunk On You.". And the release of her debut CD The Truth, with its wide ranging set of influences from P!nk to Patsy Cline, proves those years were not spent in vain.
