There are 64 Fisher Houses located on 23 military installations and 24 VA medical centers. Many more houses are under construction or in design. The Fisher House Foundation has 64 Houses in Operation, 22,000 Families served in 2013, \$235,000,000 in savings to Families since 1990 and 5.2 Million Days of Lodging for Families of Veterans.
