BOBBY BONES AND LAURA BELL BUNDY SET TO "TWO STEP FOR 30 ABES" DURING 24-HOUR EVENT

Nashville, Tenn., September 10, 2013 – Bobby Bones, host of the nationally syndicated *Bobby Bones Show*, announced today a 24-hour two step dance marathon fundraiser for 30 Abes, a charity created to feed orphans in Haiti. On Wednesday, September 18, at 7:00 a.m. CT, *The Bobby Bones Show* crew, including Bones, Amy, Lunchbox, Eddie, Alayna and Ray, along with special guest Country artist Laura Bell Bundy, will take over the dance floor at <u>aVenue</u> in Nashville, Tenn., where they will attempt to line dance for 24-hours straight while listening to Bundy's single "Two Step" on continuous play.

Listeners and fans of the show can watch "Two Step for 30 Abes" via live stream on <u>www.BobbyBones.com</u>, where they can also support the cause via texting or online donations. Those who live in Nashville can attend the event, and even join in on the dancing, from 7:00 a.m. CT on September 18 through 7:00 a.m. CT on September 19 at <u>aVenue</u> (120 3rd Avenue St.).

Bones stated, "I'm a terrible dancer, but I love raising money for good causes! I can't wait to get my 'Two Step' on!"

Bundy, who will join *The Bobby Bones Show* on-air Friday morning, September 13, to promote the event, stated: "It's wonderful to have an opportunity to give back with 'Two Step!'... dancing for donations! We are going to have a lot of fun in the process – and probably some lower back pain!"

Leading up to the Two Step event, Bones and his band The Raging Idiots will play a concert fundraiser for 30 Abes in Wichita, featuring Bundy as a special guest. She will perform her own set, in addition to joining The Raging Idiots for a few songs on Friday, September 13. This is Bundy's second performance with The Raging Idiots. She performed with the band for a local 30 Abes fundraiser in Nashville, Tenn., last month, which raised 6,000 meals for Haitian orphans.

On Saturday, September 28, 2013, thousands of volunteers in partnership with TEEMHaiti, Numana and The Bobby Bones Show will gather at Nashville Municipal Auditorium with the goal to package 500,000 meals to send to the <u>Maison Des Enfants De Dieu</u> orphanage in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. As extra motivation to meet their goal, the volunteers will also participate in a GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS official attempt for the title of "most hunger relief meals packaged in one hour" by a team. The current record of 479,034 was achieved by Numana, Volunteer Kansas and the Rotary Club of Wichita on February 16, 2013. The event will also benefit the Second Harvest Food Bank of Middle Tennessee in Nashville as packaging volunteers will be encouraged to bring canned and boxed-food donations.

30 Abes is a campaign and event created by Amy and Bobby Bones of *The Bobby Bones Show* to raise funds and bring awareness to international hunger. 30 Abes represents 30 cents, which is the cost of one life-sustaining meal. For 30 cents, Numana can provide a meal of rice, soy, dried pinto beans and a vitamin/mineral substance, as well as packaging and international shipment of the food.
