830 WCCO Hosts Minneapolis Mayoral Debate

Minneapolis/St. Paul – October 24th, 2013 – 830 WCCO is announcing a Minneapolis Mayoral Debate, one week prior to Election Day.

The debate will be held Tuesday October 29th, 7:00-9:00PM - hosted by WCCO Radio's own John Williams and political commentator Blois Olson. It will be held at the WCCO Radio Cambria Gallery on 7th at 7th Avenue and 2nd St. South in downtown Minneapolis.

Leading candidates for Minneapolis Mayor Mark Andrew, Betsy Hodges, Don Samuels, Cam Winton and Jackie Cherryhomes will participate in a 50,000 watt live mayoral candidate debate one week before Election Day. It will be the final major opportunity for each of these candidates to set themselves apart before voters head to the polls. The live debate from 7:30PM-9PM will be preceded by an interview (taped) with Mayor R.T. Rybak, reflecting on his time in office. The public is invited to attend.
