92.3 WIL ANNOUNCES NEW COUNTRY CHRISTMAS JAM CONCERT DECEMBER 16TH AT THE FAMILY ARENA

First Ever Concert Event To Feature CMA "New Artist of the Year" Hunter Hayes

ST. LOUIS – 92.3 WIL will present their first ever "New Country Christmas Jam" concert event starring CMA 2012 "New Artist of the Year" award winner and 2013 GRAMMY® nominated country artist Hunter Hayes – with special guest Kacey Musgraves – on Sunday, December 16th at The Family Arena in St. Charles, Missouri.

Although new to the country-music scene, music phenom Hunter Hayes' commitment to developing and honing his multitude of talents has resulted in a debut album that earned him a nod from the CMA as best New Artist of 2012, along with three 2012 GRAMMY nominations for "Best New Artist," "Best Country Album," and "Best Country Solo Performance". Hayes co-produced it, and wrote or co-wrote all of the songs, while singing all of the vocals and playing the 30-some instruments heard on the record.

The barn-burning "Storm Warning" became the collection's debut Gold Single. Hunter's gripping ballad "Wanted" soared to No. 1 and is quickly nearing Double Platinum status. And the lilting, groove-soaked "Somebody's Heartbreak" has become the album's third major hit –becoming a Top 30 hit in only two weeks.

Despite his youth, he already has a lifetime of musical experience. The Louisiana native began picking up various instruments when he was just 2 years old. At age four, he joined his first band, AND took his accordion on stage and sang "Jambalaya" with Hank Williams Jr. And at age six, he was cast in the Robert Duvall film *The Apostle*, and the actor also gave Hunter his first guitar.

WIL Program Director Greg Mozingo notes, "We first introduced St. Louis country music fans to Hunter Hayes back in 2011 at our 9th annual "Jinglefest" concert, and our listeners have watched as Hunter's popularity has soared, all the way to winning this year's CMA award as the 'New Artist of the Year" and multiple GRAMMY nominations!"

Mozingo adds, "Now with our first-ever 'New Country Christmas Jam' concert event, WIL is excited to be able provide our listeners with another great opportunity to enjoy Hunter Hayes and his musical provess."
