## MIX 101.5 RAISES OVER \$105,000 DURING BACKPACK BUDDIES FOOD DRIVE

Over 119,000 children in a seven county region rely on free or reduced lunches during the school year. The BackPack Buddies Program is designed to meet the needs of these children when other resources are not available by providing backpacks filled with enough food for six healthy meals and two healthy snacks that children take home on the weekend. The empty backpacks are collected after the weekend and refilled for the next weekend's use.
