Magic 92.5's Jagger & Kristi Make Dream Come True for Aspiring Singer

JUNE 21, 2013, SAN DIEGO, CA —Through Jagger & Kristi's Bucket List, an ongoing community service initiative of San Diego radio station Magic 92.5's *MAGIC Mornings with Jagger & Kristi*, aspiring singer, Kimberly Miller (Kim-E Kim), sang in front of a packed house with The Cover Girls at San Diego's Freestyle Explosion. Miller submitted her wish to sing in front of a live audience to Jagger & Kristi on www.magic925.com, and on June 8, her wish came true, thanks to the popular morning team, It's Time Salon and Four Star Transit. Freestyle Explosion was held at Valley View Casino Center and featured live performances by the biggest names in freestyle, including Stevie B, Lisa Lisa, The Cover Girls, Debbie Deb, Johnny O, Cynthia, Pretty Poison, Stacy Q, and Nocera.

As the fourth person this year to be granted her Bucket List wish, Miller, an elementary school teacher and lifelong singer, made her public singing debut as she took the stage with The Cover Girls and sang "Wishing On a Star" to over 5,000 screaming fans at Valley View Casino Center in San Diego. Jagger & Kristi also gave her a \$100 VISA gift card for a new dress to wear on stage.

Kristi Jagger said: "Kim's dream was to sing on stage and she not only appeared in front of a packed house of screaming fans with The Cover Girls, she blew them away! She was truly spectacular and what unfolded on stage was just as powerful as any *American Idol* moment. The crowd went nuts when Kim literally 'took over!'"

R Dub!, Program Director of Magic 92.5, said: "Jagger & Kristi are deeply committed to their listeners, and their Bucket List program is just one way they give back to them. It's a thrill to help make listeners' dreams come true, and we've only just begun!"

This is the fourth Bucket List item that Jagger & Kristi have facilitated for their listeners this year. Every month, San Diego radio's popular morning show team asks listeners what they want to cross off their life's "Bucket List". People submit everything from learning how to drive, skydiving, or completing a marathon.

In March on World Down Syndrome Day, Marisa Cox, a 10-year-old girl with Down Syndrome-- and a huge Justin Beiber fan—learned that she would be a

VIP guest at the upcoming Justin Beiber concert on Saturday, June 22 at San Diego's Valley View Casino Center. Much to her delight, Marisa, who suffers from a life-threatening kidney disease following a kidney transplant, will also get to meet the mega-star backstage Saturday before the show.

Earlier this year, *MAGIC Mornings with Jagger & Kristi* helped a listener who has wanted to run the San Diego Rock 'n' Roll Marathon all her life. After volunteering at water stations and training, life got in her way and she could never afford the associated costs. Now joining the U.S. Navy in August, the listener knows this is her last year to fulfill her dream of completing the marathon, which she will run on June 2, with Jagger & Kristi cheering her on.

Jagger & Kristi's Bucket List also granted the wish of a 46-year-old mother who wanted a professional photograph of her and her 11-year-old daughter. The woman has suffered from an eating disorder and low self-esteem since she was 16. Looking through her personal mementos, she realized she only had a few pictures of her and her child together. She longed for a special professional photo of her and her daughter to hold onto forever. Thanks to *MAGIC Mornings with Jagger & Kristi*, she got it.
