Bite of Las Vegas restaurants compete for the best decorated booth on-site as well as nine different "Best Bite" food categories that are judged by The International Culinary School at the Art Institute of Las Vegas.

Entertainment headliners on the House of Blues Main Stage at this year's event will be Mix 94.1 recording artists Switchfoot, Sara Bareilles, K'naan, Plain White T's, Ryan Star, Christina Perri, as well as special performances from several of Las Vegas' top shows.
